Project Summary: Fermanagh and Omagh District Council recently launched a new Quick Pick litter initiative to make it easier for residents and visitors to play their part in keeping the district clean and protect the environment.

7 'A-frame' litter picking stations will be placed in various locations throughout the district as part of the initiative. The frame will serve as a hand sanitiser station and collect a bag and litter pickers will be available for members of the public to collect litter while they enjoy their walk. Bins will be provided at the litter stations so that litter can be deposited on their return.

Aims/Objectives: To help reduce or prevent Single Use Plastics and litter harming the environment, wildlife and waterways, while creating a sense of civic pride in our own local area.
