Northern Ireland has already lost opportunities afforded by the Northern Ireland Climate Act to tackle the climate emergency due to Stormont being suspended for two years and the consequent lack of resources. Meeting targets to reduce emissions will be incredibly challenging, and changing behaviour to enable that will be even more difficult. Yet it is critical that we put our best foot forward and make sure that we have the right frameworks in place at both UK-wide and Northern Ireland levels and that the resources to properly implement the necessary changes are available.

Northern Ireland cannot operate in isolation; it needs to work with the UK government, the Irish government, and the governments in the other devolved regions. It is critical that in the next mandate our Members of Parliament press for this cooperation and ensure that Northern Ireland is properly resourced in its efforts to fight the climate emergency.

In this election, the climate and environment must be a top priority for our politicians, not just during the campaign but for the years ahead.

We want our local MPs in the next parliament to work for:


- Making Climate Education a priority in Northern Ireland and other parts of the UK.

- Introducing behaviour change schemes such as a fit for purpose Deposit Return Scheme and ensure that work on introducing this commences immediately.
- Supporting measures that can help reduce the UK's fast fashion culture. We need to promote a more circular economy across the UK if we are to reduce waste and meet our international commitments.

Bringing Everyone with Us

We recognise the need to bring people with us on this journey towards a cleaner environment underpinned by a circular economy. Getting the public to adopt the right behaviours depends on having the right policies in place and government adopting a proactive approach. The time for action is now; we cannot afford to wait. Time and again, the public has shown that when leadership is given, they will respond. Many parts of our business sector also recognise the need for change and action on the climate emergency.

- Ensure that the Internal Markets
 Act is not used to hold back
 environmental progress in
 places like Northern Ireland.

- Enabling businesses and other relevant sectors to understand the benefits of and adopt a circular economy.
- A coordinated plan of action regarding the climate emergency across the UK government, the devolved administrations and the Irish government.
